



## 2021 Virtual Show Goat Section

The Goat Section of the Virtual Stithians Show will be presented on our website in the week commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July. A photo gallery will be released showing all the exhibits and later in the week, results will also be posted online. A video of all the junior handlers will be uploaded to YouTube, along with results. Prize winners will receive a rosette in the post.

Ages at the time of photographs being taken.

Classes may be split into breeds at the discretion of the judge and the show organisers.

### DAIRY GOAT SECTION

All goats must be registered with the British Goat Club and their appropriate breed society. Registration details must be included with all entries.

**Judge: Mrs Agnes Aitken, Scotland**

Class	Description
1	FEMALE GOAT THAT HAS BORNE A KID, any age, in milk.
2	GOATLING THAT HAS NOT BORNE A KID, over one but not exceeding two years of age.
3	FEMALE KID, over two calendar months but not exceeding one year.

Ages at the time of photographs being taken.

Classes may be split into breeds at the discretion of the judge and the show organisers.

**Photographs required:** Please ensure that the goats are photographed in show condition One near side and one off side photograph, showing the entire animal. Milkers will also require a photograph from the rear showing udder and udder attachment. Please ensure that the handler cannot be identified in any photo.

**Milking Competition:**

If you currently milk record, you can enter by providing the last month's record.

Photographs must have been taken during 2021. Rosettes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in each class, including the milking competition.

**Closing Date: 12 noon, 9<sup>th</sup> June 2021**



## PYGMY GOAT SECTION

All goats must be registered with the Pygmy Goat Club, with the exception of female kids under 6 months, male kids under 12 months, wethers and pet females. Registration details, dates of birth and kidding dates must be included on the entry form. All exhibitors (except junior handlers) must be current members of the Pygmy Goat Club.

**Judge: Mrs Christine Griffiths, Wales**

Class	Description
4	JUNIOR HANDLER. A short video will be required of the junior handler walking and showing off their goat. At the beginning of the video, the handler should only state their age to the camera.
5	MALE KID
6	BUCKLING
7	ADULT MALE, 2-6 years.
8	VETERAN MALE, 7 years and over.
9	FEMALE KID
10	GOATLING
11	FEMALE ADULT, 2-6 years.
12	VETERAN FEMALE
13	PET FEMALE
14	WETHERS

Ages at the time of photographs (or videos for young handlers) being taken.

**Photographs required (except Junior Handler):** Goat must be shown in show condition

One near side and one off side photograph, showing the entire animal. Males and adult female also need to have photograph of rear showing udders (female) and testicles (male).



Photographs must have been taken during 2021. Photographs may not be edited in anyway.  
Rosettes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in each class, **Closing Date: 12 noon, 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021**

## How to enter...

E-mail your photographs to [goats@stithians.show](mailto:goats@stithians.show) including the following information:

- Class Number
- Exhibitor name & address (we will require your address to send out rosettes to winners).
- Goat name, herd book number, date of birth, date of kidding sire & dam (inc. herd book numbers).

Only one entry per e-mail. Entries limited to a maximum of 3 per person, per class. No entry fee. Entries which do not provide all the required information cannot be accepted.

### Young Handlers

Please send your videos using WeTransfer.com (a free video transfer service) to [information@stithians.show](mailto:information@stithians.show). Only one video per transfer. Please include in the notes the Young Handler's name, age and address (we will require your address to send out rosettes).

The making of an entry is irrevocable consent for the storage and disclosure of information in this way.*
